Yardage

Dark Blue - 1.5 yd
Light Blue - .5 yd
Dark Red - 1 yd
Light Red - .75 yd
White - 3 yd

Backing - 3.5 yds
Batting - Twin Size

8 - Rectangle	-	-	-	-	12
1.5" Strip	-	4	-	-	4
2.5" Strip	7 (Binding)	-	10	-	18
4.5" Strip	4	-	-	5

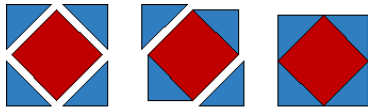
Fabrics - Island Batik

Thread - Aurifil Threads

AccuQuilt - Ready-Set-GO! System w/ 8" Qube die set

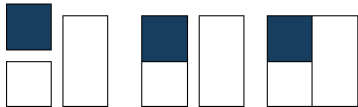




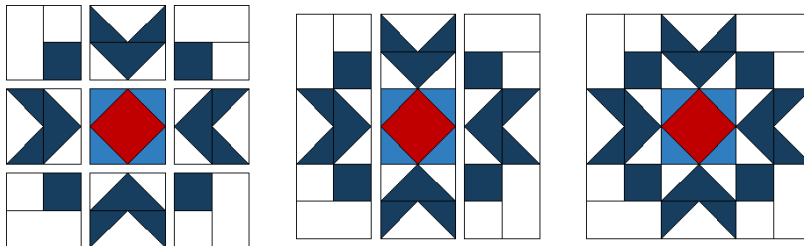
Sew The light blue HSTs to the red squares. Make three units.



Sew white HSTs to the dark blue QSTs, and sew dark blue HSTs to the white QSTs. Make twelve of each, and sew together to make twelve V units.



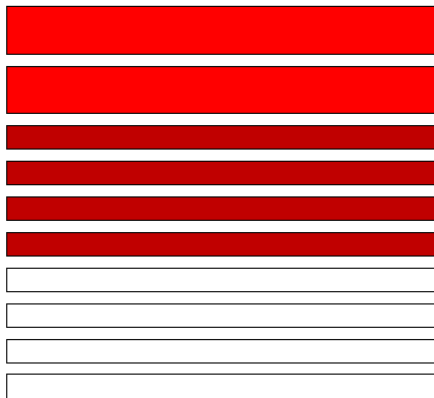
Sew the white and dark blue squares together, and sew to the white



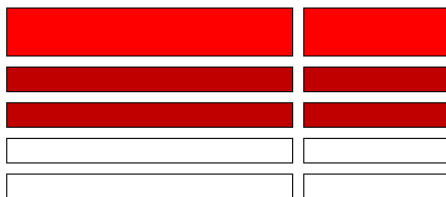
Lay out the units as shown. Sew into rows, then sew the rows together to complete a star block. Make three blocks.



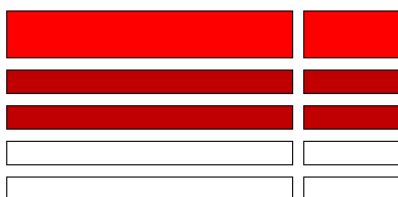
Trim one light red, two dark red and two white strips to 40.5" long.



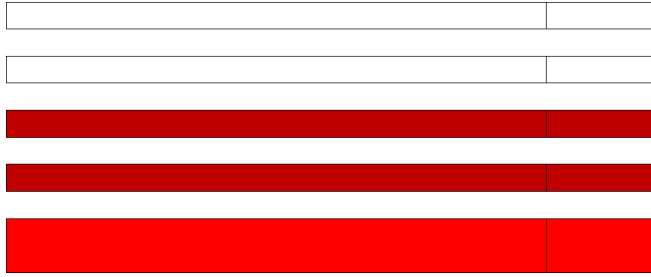
Trim two light red, four dark red, and four white strips to 36.5" long.



Trim one light red, two dark red, and two white strips to 24.5" long. Cut 12.5" strips from the remnants.

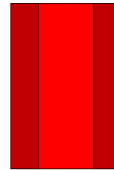
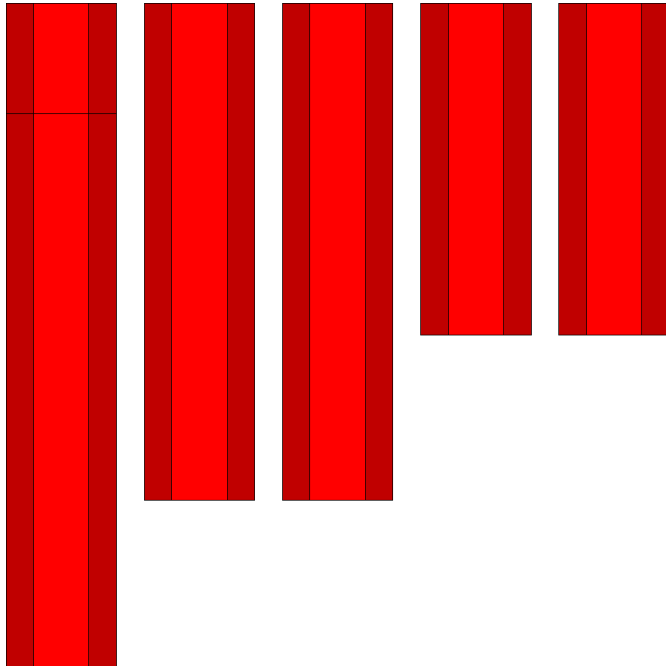


Trim one light red, two dark red, and two white strips to 24.5" long. Cut 8.5" strips from the remnants.



Sew the 8.5" strips to the ends of the 40.5" strips.

Set the white strips aside.



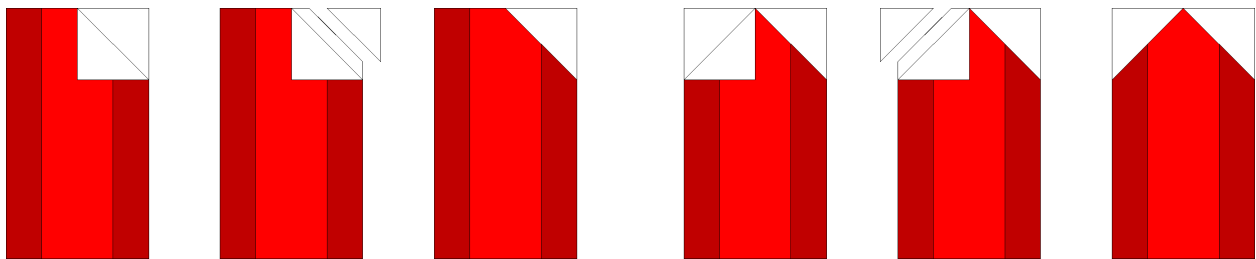
Sew all of the red strips into stripsets, sandwiching the 4.5" wide lighter red strips between the 2.5" wide darker strips.

One stripset will be 48.5" long.

Two stripsets will be 36.5" long.

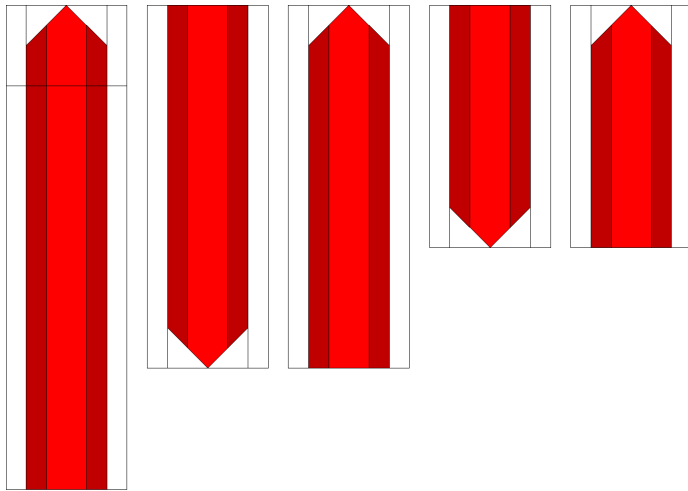
Two stripsets will be 24.5" long.

One stripset will be 12.5" long.



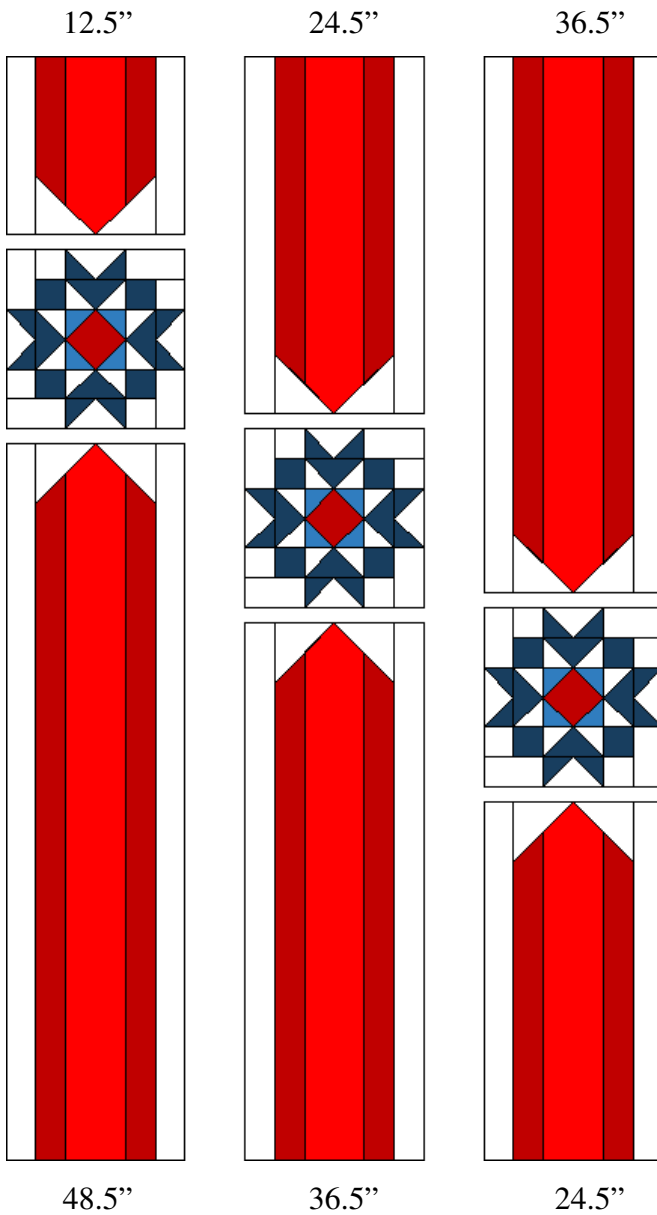
Use the 4.5" white squares and the Stitch and Flip method to put white corners on one end of each of the red strip sets.

Note: If either of your red fabrics is directional, Be sure that the point is on the top end of the 48.5" stripset, and the bottom of the 12.5" stripset. One 36.5" stripset and one 24.5" stripset should point up, and the others should point down. (See the illustration at the top of page 4)



Now add the 2.5" wide white strips to the sides of each strip-sets.

Your stripsets should now be 12.5" wide.



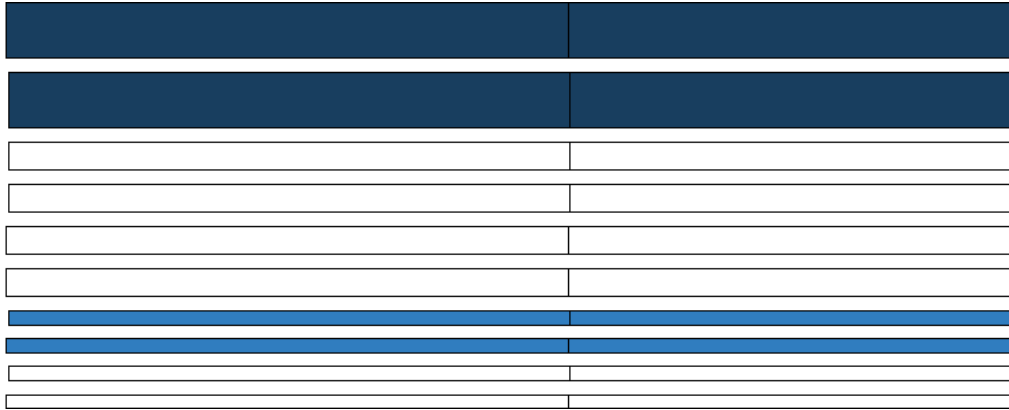
Sew the strip sets to the star blocks to make three rows.

The left row has a 12.5" stripset and 48.5" stripset.

The middle row has a 24.5" stripset on top and a 36.5" stripset at the bottom.

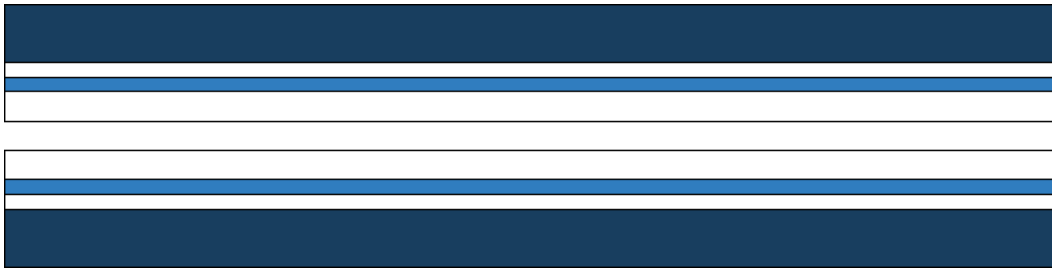
The right row has a 36.5" stripset on top and a 24.5" stripset at the bottom.

Each row should be 72.5" long.

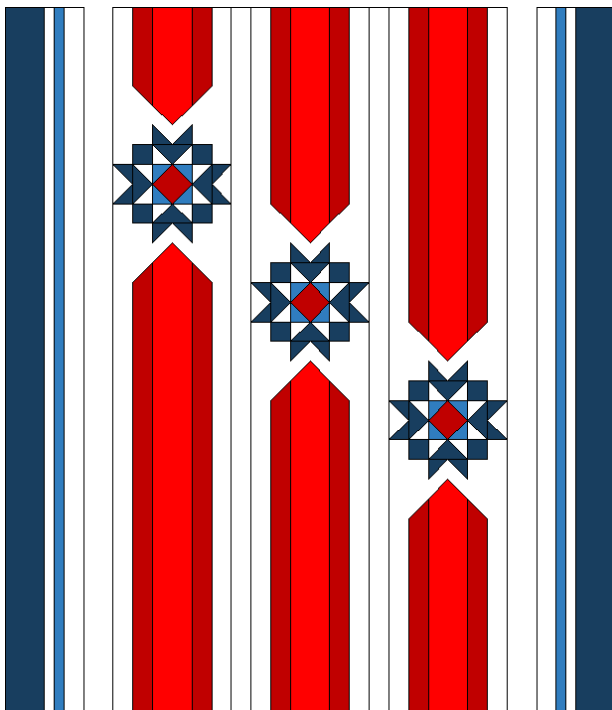


Trim the selvedge ends from the 4.5" dark blue strips. Sew end-to-end in pairs, and trim each pair to 72.5" long.

Repeat with the 2.5" white strips, and the 1.5" light blue strips and white strips.



Sew the 4.5" dark blue, 2.5" white strips, 1.5" light blue strips and 1.5" white strips into two border stripsets as shown. The remaining two 2.5" white strips will be used for sashing.



Sew the star rows together, separated by 2.5" white sashing strips.

Sew one border stripset to the left side of the Center panel and the other border stripset to the right side.

This completes your Service Stars quilt top.

Cut the backing yardage into two 63" x Width of Fabric pieces. Trim the selvages and set the pieced together into a 63" x 82" backing.

Quilt as desired.

Use the 2.5" dark blue strips for binding.
